



## 4WD Track Classifications

Port Hunter 4x4 Club Inc. recommends that recovery gear be carried on every 4WD trip

### Green – Easy

Roads with no obstacles and minor gradients - Suitable for all wheel drives, with road tyres and novice drivers.

### Blue – Medium

Mainly High Range 4WD but Low Range required. Some 4WD experience recommended.

Tracks with some steep and/or rocky/slippery/sandy sections. May have shallow water crossings. Suitable for medium clearance vehicles with dual range and all terrain or road tyres. Recommended that drivers have experience or 4WD training. Recommended to be done in groups of vehicles

## **Black - Difficult**

**Significant Low Range 4WD with standard 4WD ground clearance. Should have 4WD driver training. Tracks with frequent steep and/or rocky/slippery/sandy sections. Possible water crossings. Suitable for medium to high clearance vehicles with dual range and all terrain tyres. Recommended for drivers with reasonable experience or 4WD training. To be done in groups of vehicles**

## **Red - Very Difficult**

**Low Range 4WD with High ground clearance. Experienced Drivers Only. Tracks with frequent very steep and/or rocky/slippery/sandy sections. May have difficult river crossings. Suitable for high clearance vehicles with dual range and tyres suitable for the terrain. Drivers with extensive experience and advanced training should only attempt as there are several technical challenges. Recommended to be done in groups of four or more vehicles**
